COMMENTS

I have found fees to be quite reasonable, but I'm sure there are people who will have a hard time affording it. My parents could not when I was a child so I did not do kiwanis festivals, but rather conservatory exams only.

I hope you don't implement a single-child penalty. I find it really upsetting when organizations penalize single-child families by offering multi-child families discounts, especially when there is no basis for the discount, i.e., a fixed-dollar-amount discount is warranted, if there is reduced administration/processing.

So nice to see you are looking for ways to make the festival even better.

Keep fees as low as possible so as not to discourage participation from students in all income brackets.

If the fees are lower and/or nil, I believe more participants would register. These children would like to show what they can do.

I think the classes are expensive.

The committee does a great job. Perhaps try to reduce the fee for the wee ones who only play for 30 seconds and charge more for a concert group or concerto which takes a lot of time to adjudicate

I think the entry fees are fair.

Cost doesn't seem to be a factor for parents, but my students have only participated in two classes max.

I pulled my students from the festival several years ago because of the cost. When adding collaborative pianist fees, it is way too expensive. In addition, the adjudicators were not always great choices. Would love to bring them back!

Cutting down on fees would help tremendously for families who can't afford participating. Specially if they have more than 1 child. Its already expensive to take lessons. I'm sure many more would participate in the kiwanis festival if the fees were more affordable. Thanks
