1. Instruments Division

2. Repertoire Selection

2.1. The participant may perform a single movement from a multi-movement work or a single movement work for solo instrument and orchestra.

2.1.1. Ensemble concertos (such as the Beethoven Triple Concerto) are permitted. They may enter as long as one of the instruments in the ensemble fits the instrument division for that year.

2.2. Participants will be ineligible to win the competition if the orchestral parts to their concerto are not available on IMSLP.

3. Class Procedures

3.1. All participants will play on a single evening in recital form (one after the other without break).

3.2. The participants must perform with live accompaniment.

3.3. The adjudicator will not give comments or award marks, ribbons or seals.

4. Class Results

4.1. The adjudicator may select up to six winners. All decisions are final.

4.2. Results will be announced on the festival website concerto competition page after all festival classes have been completed.

4.3. Winners will play with the Kitchener-Waterloo Community Orchestra later that season.

4.4. The participant must play the same concerto that they played in the competition in the concert.
